Items that will be collected are furniture, tree limbs, bags of leaves, general construction debris, etc., all items must be at least 15 feet from dumpster. The next free trash pickup will be in **APRIL!**

#### Non-Collectible Items:

gasoline, antifreeze, tires and any other automobile part; batteries, mercury, pesticides, fluorescent bulbs, used motor oil, medications, cleaners, paint, ballasts and herbicides, electronics (televisions, computers, computer parts, etc), are not eligible for curbside pick up.
